

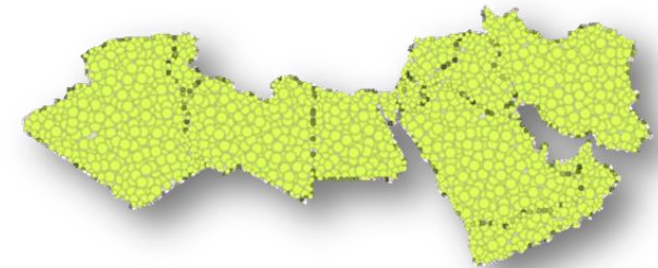


MENA Oil and Gas Conferences
