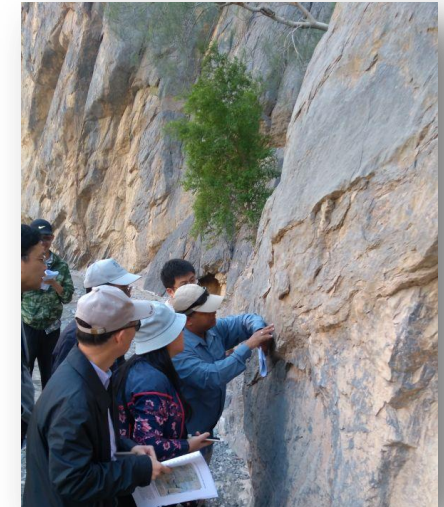


Geological Fieldtrips
